Jörg Gasser (1969), MA, CEO of the Swiss Bankers Association (SBA)

Jörg Gasser has long-standing experience and a broad-based track record in domestic as well as international politics, diplomacy and financial market policy.

Jörg Gasser began his career at the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), where he spent ten years working in the Near and Middle East. He subsequently occupied senior positions with the Swiss government, including interim Director of the Federal Office for Migration, and Secretary General of the Federal Department of Justice and Police (FDJP) and the Federal Department of Finance (FDF). In 2016, the Federal Council appointed him to the post of State Secretary of the Federal Department of Finance, where he was responsible for developing and implementing Switzerland's international financial and tax policy, as well as its financial market regulation. In 2018, the magazine Bilanz named him as a “digital shaper”, one of the leaders in digitalisation in Switzerland.

Jörg Gasser has a master's degree in economics and international relations from the University of Zurich as well as a bachelor's degree in astronomy from the Swinburne University of Technology in Melbourne.

Jörg Gasser has been CEO of the Swiss Bankers Association since May 2019.
