Giorgio Pradelli (1967) **Chairman of the Swiss Bankers Association (SBA)** **CEO of EFG International and EFG Bank**

Giorgio Pradelli has been a member of the Board of Directors of the Swiss Bankers Association since 2023, serving as its Chairman from September 2026. He became Vice-Chairman of *economiesuisse* in September 2026 and is also a member of the Executive Board of the Swiss American Chamber of Commerce in Zurich.

With more than 30 years experience in the international financial sector, Giorgio Pradelli has extensive experience working with Swiss committees and associations through his own long-standing involvement in them. He holds a degree in Economics and Business Administration from the University of Turin, Italy.

Giorgio Pradelli has been CEO of EFG International and EFG Bank since January 2018. In this capacity, he is also Chairman of the Executive Committees of EFG International and EFG Bank, as well as of EFG International's Global Business Committee. In addition, he holds several non-executive board positions in other entities directly or indirectly controlled by EFG International.

Prior to his appointment as CEO, Giorgio Pradelli was Deputy CEO and CFO at EFG International and EFG Bank since January 2014 and June 2012 respectively. Before joining EFG International, he was Head of International Operations at Eurobank Ergasias SA and a member of the Executive Committee from 2006 to 2012. From 2003 to 2006, he served as Deputy Finance Director in London for EFG Bank European Financial Group SA, where he participated in major restructuring and strategic initiatives, notably the initial public offering of EFG International in 2005.

His career began at Deutsche Bank, where he held a number of senior management positions from 1991 to 2003, including Head of Private & Business Banking in Italy and Head of Business Development for the Private Clients and Asset Management Group in Frankfurt and London.
